

**Unanimous Resolutions passed by the 'Wilderness Resurgence' seminar
Convened by the Greater Blue Mountains Wilderness Network
at Blackheath, 28th March 2004**

"That this meeting of citizens of NSW supports the restoration of the Coolangubra Wilderness."

"That this meeting of citizens of NSW supports the nomination of a Tantawangalo Wilderness under the *Wilderness Act, 1987*."

"That this meeting of citizens of NSW opposes the establishment of a 4WD vehicle public access circuit around Mount Yengo in the Yengo Wilderness area."

"That this meeting of citizens of NSW opposes the taking of images for the 'Stealth' film within the Grose Wilderness, we do not oppose the taking of images from outside the wilderness."

"That this meeting of citizens of NSW meeting at Blackheath expresses its view to Premier, the Hon. Bob Carr, and the Environment Minister, the Hon. Bob Debus that management of wilderness in NSW requires the establishment of an adequately resourced and empowered Wilderness Unit within the Department of Environment and Conservation. This meeting asks the Government to establish such a Wilderness Unit immediately."
